

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Kenneth B. Bennett Memorial Scholarship is limited to students enrolled or planning to enroll in a four-year teacher preparation program. Each applicant must:

- Be a member of Virginia Educators Credit Union (VECU) who has not previously been awarded a scholarship from VECU.
- Be a full-time student entering the education profession.
- Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
- Submit a one-to-two page, typed, double-spaced essay with a font size of 12.
- Submit a sealed copy of your most recent high school or college transcript.

All materials, including the Application, Essay, and sealed Transcript **must be received by VECU by 5:00 pm on April 1, 2010 to be considered.** Essay and application may be emailed to: financialliteracy@vecu.org.

The \$1,500 scholarship is paid directly to the winner's college or university. Once registered, please forward enrollment verification from your school to Virginia Educators Credit Union (VECU).
