SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Educators Scholarship is designed to assist full-time teachers enrolling in continuing education programs at 4-year institutions. Each applicant must:

- Be a member of Virginia Educators Credit Union (VECU) who has not previously been awarded a scholarship from VECU.
- Be a full-time educator who teaches at a public or private school, college, or university within VECU's field of membership.
- Submit a one-to-two page, typed, double-spaced essay with a font size of 12.

All materials, including the Application and Essay must be received by VECU by 5:00 pm on Friday, March 3, 2017 to be considered. Essay and application may be emailed to: financialliteracy@vecu.org.

The \$1,500 scholarship will be provided for the winning applicant for re-certification classes or other classes for certification or endorsement, in which the winner is planning to enroll, up to but not to exceed \$1,500. The course(s) must be taken within the year of the scholarship.
