# (SIMPLE TIPS FOR AVOIDING IDENTITY THEFT)

Many Americans are concerned about someone stealing their credit card, check, or debit card numbers, but they may be ignoring an easy way thieves can access financial accounts: receipts and passwords.

Disregarding receipts that have valuable information greatly increases the risk of credit and debit card fraud. Thieves can easily find receipts with financial or personal information in trash cans. Here are some easy steps you can take to prevent thieves from stealing your financial information:

- Shred all preapproved credit offers received in the mail, credit and debit card receipts, insurance forms, financial statements, and other paperwork containing personal or financial information.
- Check credit union statements and other financial statements monthly for discrepancies and order a credit report once a year to make sure no one else is using your personal information to obtain credit cards or services at annualcreditreport.com.
- Do not carry your Social Security card in your wallet.
- Do not share or carry any passwords on your person.
- Be hesitant about giving personal or financial information over the telephone—make sure you know the caller and know how the information will be used. (VECU has your personal and financial information, so we will not need to call you for this.)







# **Enhanced Internet Branch (Moneylink)** is Here with Updated Free Mobile Apps!

Our updated Internet Branch (Moneylink) is available for your convenience which offers enhanced security and user functions! To sign into the updated site, visit <a href="www.vecu.org">www.vecu.org</a> and select Account Login from the homepage. You will initially use your account number, and will then need to create your own unique username which will require 6 digits with at least 1 number. You may keep your current password if it meets the length requirements and does not include your account number. There is a tutorial available for your convenience on the site, and the location of key elements are in the same location you are familiar with. An updated free VECU App is available for download in the App Store or Google Play Store by searching VECU.
